Dear Business Owners/Residents:

As you know after many years of concern over the traffic problem at Ypsilanti Street and Main Street, it was decided to do a test closure of Ypsilanti Street. Under the direction of SEMCOG (South East Michigan Council of Governments) Traffic Engineers, Spicer Engineering, and the Dundee Police Department, the year-long trial was conducted.

The closure improved traffic and pedestrian safety and Council voted to permanently close Ypsilanti Street at Main Street. Closure of Ypsilanti Street is an important element of the Safe Routes to School Grant through SEMCOG.

The Village has now moved into the design phase of the closure and is hosting a workshop on Tuesday July 17th from 6:00pm-7:00pm at the Village Office. The focus of this one hour workshop is to gather ideas for the design of the streetscape in the walking area created by the closure.

We are cordially inviting you to attend the workshop and look forward to your ideas on design. Your ideas will help create an area that everyone can enjoy with their families.
