#### VILLAGE MANAGER REPORT

Manager Uhl reported that the Village has entered into a contract with Toledo Aerial to promote local business through a Business Spotlight video. The pilot show introduced Papa Johns. Paperless meetings are being investigated. The Village is investigating partnering with Monroe County Community College in business and municipality training at the Village office. Building Inspector Gary Dahl reported that plans are being reviewed for two hundred and five apartments to be constructed by Bell Estates. Police Chief Garbo reported that they are moving forward with report writing for the county. On April 6<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 10 am and 1 pm we are partnering with Wolverine Toyota for the Safe Kids USA program. We will be participating in the National Zero Tolerance Distracted Drivers program on April 11<sup>th</sup>. Traffic enforcement on US-23 is for safety issues such as reducing speeds to reduce traffic accidents and commercial weight limits. The cars on US-23 are traffic and weight limit cars not the cars used to answer calls in the Village. The State Police will be placing a midnight car on duty in Dundee starting April 6<sup>th</sup>. Manager Uhl and Theresa Coleman attended the Monroe County Chamber of Commerce annual meeting today. DPW supervisor Gary Dahl and Manager Uhl will be attending the truck shows at the Wayne County Airport on March 21<sup>st</sup>. The Village vac truck was sent to the Dundee Township Fire Hall to pump out the sewage grinder that was plugged.
